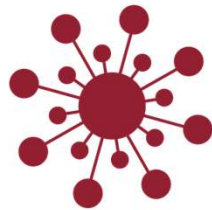

Steering Committee and Mentorship

- Goal to increase knowledge and improve practice of IPC within Tribal health facilities
- Implement a training and capacity building assistance program to raise the capacity of infection control for Indian Health professionals and health providers
- Assist with developing and/or adapting existing materials to inform Tribal health professionals about important components of IPC



Steering Committee and Mentorship Program Cont'd

- Steering Committee will assist with forming mentorship program
- Establish relationship between infection control professionals and Tribal health officials interested in expanding their knowledge on infection control practices
- To share infection prevention knowledge using personal and career experiences



Scholarship Opportunity

- Scholarships for Tribal Infection Control Officers and Health Officials
- May be used for online infection control training courses
- May also be used to complete the Certification Board of Infection Control and Epidemiologists (CBIC) certification exam

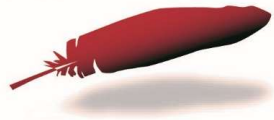
